<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Countries included in this publication are several major industrial countries, Europe countries, Asia countries (include ASEAN), Latin and Central America and selected Africa countries. • The data consists of GDP, inflation, current account, export and import growth, reserve assets, USD exchange rate againts several other major currencies and SDRs, international interest rates, central bank discount rates and price indexes of several important commodities in world markets. • Reserve Assets consists of Special Drawing Right (SDR) allocation, Reserve Position in the Fund (RPF) and foreign exchange reserves, not including monetary gold. • Interest rate data consists of LIBOR and SIBOR interest rates (1, 3, 6 and 12 months); several primary interest rates (US and Japan Prime Rates).
